



## FAMILY CAMPGROUND GUIDELINES

### **Help us maintain the natural setting God has given us by . . .**

- using precut firewood from the Trading Post. Please do not cut live or dead trees from the woods.
- not transporting firewood onto Walcamp property. Help us prevent the spread of the emerald ash borer.
- building campfires in the designated fire pits. Please do not relocate fire pits.
- leaving ashes in the fire pits for Walcamp staff to remove.
- disposing of trash, glass and cans properly, and not placing them in fire pits.

### **To be a good neighbor and help keep Walcamp family-friendly please . . .**

- make sure lights and other decorative items are kept to a minimum and are acceptable in a family setting. Outside lights must be turned off upon retiring for the evening.
- keep your campsite clean and free of litter. Place trash in the dumpster at the entrance to the North Loop of the campground. For those who wish to recycle, there is a recycling dumpster at the lower level behind the Lodge.
- capture all waste water in containers and deposit at the dump stations.
- remember that all alcoholic beverages must be consumed on individual campsites. Kegs, barrels or other bulk tap quantities are permitted only with prior consent of the Executive Director.
- parents are responsible for children at all times. Children under 16 should be on their own site by 10:00 pm unless accompanied by an adult.
- radios, musical instruments, televisions and pets must not be as loud as to be heard on adjacent sites. Remember quiet hours are: Monday – Thursday 9:00 pm to 8:00 am, and Friday & Saturday 10:00 pm to 8:00 am.

### **Camp site and Cabin reminders . . .**

- **RV site fee includes** one RV unit per site. A tent is permitted on an RV site for an additional fee of \$10 per night, with a limit of one tent per site.
- **Rustic Tent site fee includes** one tent per site.
- **Camping cabins** are non-smoking. Pets are not allowed in buildings.
- Please remember that check in time is 1 pm on Friday; check out is by 3 pm on Sunday.

### **For the safety of all guests . . .**

- we ask that you comply with all state and federal regulations regarding controlled substances, alcohol consumption and the operation of any motor vehicles (including golf carts and utility vehicles).
- campground speed limit is 10 MPH.
- all campsites are permitted two vehicles per site. Please park on the gravel pads. Please park additional vehicles parked in designated visitor parking areas.
- mini-bikes, dirt bikes, ATV's and four-wheelers are not allowed at Walcamp. Trails are for hiking only.
- firearms or fireworks are not permitted at Walcamp.
- swimming and canoeing are permitted during designated times When lifeguards are on duty.

### **Walcamp is pet- friendly and we welcome your “furry” family members, so please . . .**

- have two pets per site.
- keep pets on a leash.
- pick up and dispose of pet waste promptly.
- remember that pets are not allowed on the beach or in any of the buildings, including the camping cabins and bath houses.
